JOB SUMMARY

Under general direction performs skilled installation, testing, repairs, troubleshooting, preventive maintenance on revenue equipment, communications equipment, destination signs, camera/surveillance equipment, various electronic and electrical components and systems, and other related equipment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Required to do installs, repairs, replaces, troubleshoots, or modifies electronic and electrical components/systems and defective parts for a variety of equipment and systems such as; radio/communications equipment; destination signs; security/camera equipment; farebox and other revenue handling equipment. Fabricates; installs and calibrates special equipment and components. Inspects and repairs equipment, components, wiring and systems installed by contractors or vendors. Performs bench repair of electronic equipment/systems; installs cabling in walls, ceilings and conduit; diagnoses failures. Documents defects and monitors electronic/equipment maintenance reports; records and tracks maintenance activities and requirements. Schedules and performs preventive maintenance; operates computer for related data input and retrieval; maintains parts inventory records.

KNOWLEDGE & ABILITY

Mechanical aptitude in the maintenance and repair of electronic system, including conducting Preventive Maintenance (PM), troubleshooting and repairing problems; the use of electronic test equipment; ability to read and interpret maintenance manuals, schematics and diagrams and proficient in the use of computer software including Windows Operating System. Ability to follow written and verbal instructions, including maintenance publications and work on specific tasks with small parts for extended periods.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

Minimum two years education equivalent of an A.S. degree, training and/or experience in electronic systems. Experience in electronic systems, electronic component maintenance and repair required; hands on experience with fareboxes. Or, up to 2 years full-time training or education in DC, AC, electronic devices, advanced communications, and digital electronics at a recognized trade school or apprenticeship program or 2 years work experience.
