MST HIGHLIGHTS March 7, 2016 BOARD MEETING

MARCH EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2016-19, recognizing Noe Figueroa, Entry Level Mechanic, as the March 2016 Employee of the Month for his outstanding contributions to MST.

AUTHORIZE MASTER AGREEMENT OF THE TRANSIT AND INTERCITY RAIL PROGRAM (TIRCP)

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2016-20 authorizing the execution of the TIRCP Master Agreement and Program Supplements for State-Funded Transit Projects.

APPOINT MST REPRESENTATIVES TO CALIFORNIA TRANSIT INDEMNITY POOL (CALTIP) BOARD

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2016-21 appointing the Director of Human Resources and the Risk and Security Manager to serve as representatives to the CalTIP Board of Directors.

AWARD CONTRACT FOR LEGAL SERVICES

The MST Board unanimously approved awarding a contract to Meyers-Nave to provide legal services for the financing of MST's proposed South County facility.

ADOPT MST'S SECTION 5307 PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

The MST Board conducted a public hearing and unanimously adopted a 5307 Program of Projects, which allows MST to receive federal funding, which will pay for operational expenses totaling \$7,090,800 in fiscal year 2016.

AUTHORIZE REMODEL EXPENSES FOR 19 UPPER RAGSDALE OFFICES

The MST Board unanimously approved remodel expenses for MST offices at 19 Upper Ragsdale, Monterey, not to exceed \$440,000.

PROVIDE CONGESTION RELIEF BUS PASSES FOR HIGHWAY 68 ROUNDABOUT PROJECT

The MST Board declared a Congestion Emergency due to the upcoming Holman Highway 68 Roundabout construction project and authorized the sale of a \$13 per month Temporary Congestion Relief Pass for residents and workers in impacted areas.
