APRIL EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2018-21 recognizing Paul Lopez as the April 2018 Employee of the Month for his outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.

2017 COACH OPERATOR EXCELLENCE AWARD

The MST Board of Directors unanimously adopted resolution 2018-22 to recognize the 2017 Coach Operator Excellence Award recipients, Ruben Cano, Carlos Dominquez and Tiziano Minelli.

ADOPTED RESOLUTION 2018-23 TO SUPPORT PROPOSITION 69

The MST Board of Directors unanimously adopted resolution 2018-23 supporting proposition 69 and opposing "The Road Repair and Accountability Act" (SB-1-Beal) Repeal, and Approval to Join the Coalition to Protect Local Transportation Improvements Resolution No. 18-26.

APPROVED PURCHASE OF FIVE BUS PASS VENDING MACHINES

The MST Board of Directors unanimously approved the purchase of five (5) military bus pass vending machines and associated software costing \$97,995 which will be funded from the federal mass transit benefit program.

The MST Board of Directors received an update on the progress of planning, permitting and financing for the South County Maintenance and Operations facility in King City.

AUTHORIZED THE PURCHASE OF MAINTENANCE SERVICE TRUCK

The MST Board authorized the purchase of one maintenance service truck with aftermarket equipment and components not to exceed \$40,000.
