APPROVED REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS

The Monterey-Salinas Transit (MST) Board approved resolution 2022-26 proclaiming a state of emergency and authorizing teleconference meetings in accordance with the Brown Act.

RECOGNIZED APRIL EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2022-27 recognizing Michael Cajobe, Maintenance Mechanic, as the April 2022 Employee of the Month for his outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.

APPROVED RETIREMENT RESOLUTIONS
