MARCH EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2020-17 recognizing Raul Guerrero as the March 2020 Employee of the Month for his outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.

MEASURE Q OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

The MST Board unanimously approved the re-appointment of committee members, Sid Williams, Juan Pablo Lopez, Kevin Dayton, Sharlene Hughes, and Aimee Cuda to the MST Measure Q Oversight Committee.

MOBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS

The MST Board unanimously approved the appointment of Bobby Merritt, Joseph Ruiz, and Maria Magana to the MST Mobility Advisory Committee.

CONDUCTED PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVED 2020 PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

The MST Board conducted a public hearing, unanimously approved the FY 2020 Program of Projects and the filing of the appropriate grant applications with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and Caltrans.

AUTHORIZED PURCHASE OF RANGER MOBILE DATA TERMINALS

The MST Board unanimously approved the purchase and configuration of 40 Trapeze Ranger Mobile Data Terminals (MDTs) that interface with the Paratransit Trapeze PASS AVL system in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.

AMENDMENT TO MST AND MONTEREY PENINSULA COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP

The MST Board unanimously approved a contract amendment with Monterey Peninsula College to expand the free zone program system wide.

FREE FARE PROMOTIONS

The MST Board unanimously approved the MST Free Fare Promotions including the Measure Q Funded Free Fare Week in May 2020 for persons with disabilities, seniors and veterans.
