November 10, 2014 BOARD MEETING

NOVEMBER EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board adopted Resolution 2015-15 recognizing Randy Ascencio, intermediate mechanic, as the November Employee of the Month for his positive contribution to MST and to the entire community.

APPROVE GENERAL MANAGER EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

The MST Board approved the General Manager/CEO's job description and three year employment agreement.

APPROVE GENERAL MANGER PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE

The MST Board approved the General Manager/CEO's annual performance incentive.

PURCHASE RIDES BUSES

The MST Board authorized the purchase of eight medium sized min- buses from Creative Bus Sales for the MST RIDES program. The vehicles are 100 percent funded through the Federal Transit Administration's Section 5310 program and Transportation Development Toll Credits.

MEASURE Q ELECTION RESULTS

General Manager and CEO, Carl Sedoryk, announced the success of Measure Q. Election results show the measure passed with a 72.4 percent approval. Revenues from Measure Q will be used to maintain transit services for seniors, veterans, and people with disabilities. The Board will begin discussing the establishment of a Citizen's Oversight Committee and spending plans for the sales tax revenues.
