NOVEMBER EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2018-08 recognizing Miriam Gutierrez as the November 2017 Employee of the Month for her outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.

APPROVED REVISED DISPOSAL OF LOST AND FOUND POLICY

The MST Board unanimously approved the revised lost and found property policy to be in compliance with State law, which extends the period of time MST holds lost property from 30 days to 3 months and requires unclaimed items to be auctioned.

APPROVED GENERAL MANAGER/CEO PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE

The MST Board unanimously approved the Incentive Pay for the General Manager/CEO based upon his performance in accordance with achievement of the Board adopted goals and objectives of 4.75%.

APPROVED UPGRADES AT CJW FOR ELECTRIC BUSES

The MST Board unanimously approved the expenditure of up to \$300,000 to upgrade the electrical power system at the Clarence Wright (CJW) bus operations and maintenance facility in Salinas to accommodate electric buses.
