#### **APPROVED REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS**

The Monterey-Salinas Transit (MST) Board approved resolution 2022-14 proclaiming a state of emergency and authorizing remote teleconference meetings in accordance with the Brown Act.

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2022-15 recognizing Abel Diaz, as the November 2021 Employee of the Month for his outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.
