MST HIGHLIGHTS November 9, 2015 BOARD MEETING

NOVEMBER EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board adopted Resolution 2016-10 recognizing Nelson De Gracia, coach operator, as the November Employee of the Month for his positive contribution to MST and to the entire community.

APPROVE RESOLUTION 2016-11 AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FTA LOW OR NO EMISSION VEHICLE DEPLOYMENT

The MST Board approved Resolution 2016-11 authorizing MST staff to file an application for the Federal Transit Administration's Low or No Emission Vehicle Deployment program.

APPROVE GENERAL MANAGER INCENTIVE PAY

The MST Board approved an incentive pay for the General Manager/CEO, based on his performance meeting the board-adopted goals and objectives during fiscal year 2015, in the amount of \$9,094.18.

PURCHASE FOUR NEW BUS SHELTERS

The MST Board approved the purchase of four new bus shelters from Tolar Manufacturing in the amount of \$27,900, or \$6,975 each, not including tax/shipping.

AUTHORIZE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR 19 UPPER RAGSDALE DR., SUITE 200

The MST Board authorized staff to sign a purchase agreement for 19 Upper Ragsdale Dr., Suite 200, in Monterey, CA, in the amount of \$2,549,250, to be used as MST's administrative offices.

AUTHORIZE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR 19 UPPER RAGSDALE DR., SUITE 100

The MST Board authorized staff to sign a purchase agreement for 19 Upper Ragsdale Dr., Suite 100, in Monterey, CA, in the amount of \$2,549,250, to be used as MST's administrative offices.

CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVE RIDES FARE CLASSIFICATION CHANGES

The MST Board held a public hearing and approved changes to MST RIDES fare classifications, reducing the maximum distance for a \$5.00 RIDES paratransit trip from 19.7 to 17.0 miles. The change is required to maintain compliance with ADA regulations.

APPROVE INCLUDING VETERANS IN MST'S HALF-FARE DISCOUNT PROGRAM AND CREATE 75-CENT FARE FOR HALF-FARE ELIGIBLE PASSENGERS ON SENIOR SHUTTLE ROUTES

The MST Board approved including veterans in MST's established half-fare discount program and created a special 75-cent fare for half-fare discount-eligible passengers on MST's senior shuttle routes.
