### **October 16, 2017 Board Meeting**

#### **SEPTEMBER EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH**

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2018-06, recognizing Beronica Carriedo, as the September 2017 Employee of the Month for her outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.

#### **RETIREMENT RESOLUTION**

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2018-077 recognizing Robert Llorin, Coach Operator for 8 years of service and his outstanding dedication and contribution to MST and the entire community.

#### **APPROVED PERFORMANCE INCENTIVE POOL**

The MST Board unanimously approved the Performance Incentive Pool for eligible MSTEAs and Confidential Unit employees per recommendation from the General Manager/CEO.

#### **AUTHORIZED PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT RADIOS**

The MST Board unanimously authorized the purchase and configuration of replacement radios for the Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) system, not to exceed \$38,000.
