OCTOBER 11, 2021 Board Meeting

APPROVED REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS

The Monterey-Salinas Transit (MST) Board approved resolution 2022-09 proclaiming a state of emergency and authorizing remote teleconference meetings in accordance with the Brown Act.

RECOGNIZED OCTOBER EMPLOYEE OF THE MONTH

The MST Board unanimously adopted Resolution 2022-10 recognizing Christine Church, as the October 2021 Employee of the Month for her outstanding contribution to MST and to the entire community.

APPROVED RETIREMENT RESOLUTIONS

The MST Board approved retirement resolution 2022-11 recognizing Mark Eccles, Director of Information Technology, for his 20 years of service and outstanding contribution to MST and the entire community. The Board approved retirement resolution 2022-12 recognizing Cindy Rodriguez, Operations Supervisor, for her 27 years of service and outstanding contribution to MST and the entire community. APPROVED PURCHASE OF FOUR NEW HEAVY-DUTY COACH BUSES

The MST Board authorized the purchase of four (4) heavy-duty coaches from Gillig, LLC of California in an amount not to exceed \$2,366,000.
